Argyll East School Community Matariki Hangi

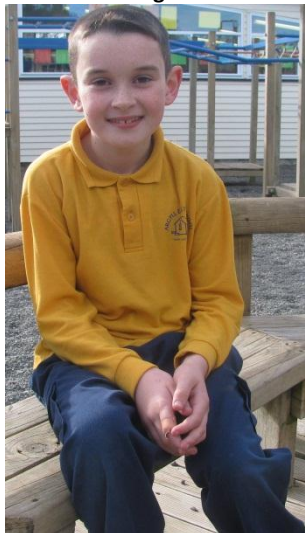
