Kia ora koutou,

This week is "Te wiki o te reo Māori". Māori Language Week has been celebrated each year from 1975 and commemorates the presentation of the 1972 Maori Language Petition to parliament. 'Kia kaha' is well understood in New Zealand English with its meaning of 'be strong'. So, when we say 'Kia kaha te reo Māori' we're saying - 'Let's make the Māori language strong'.

It's fantastic to have everyone back together at school. Annabelle has been in this week carrying on with hockey lessons and the children are enjoying the sessions. The beautiful rain means that we will complete our sessions when the weather is favourable.

Since returning to school, we have had both Mr Stuckey and Miss Hall absent with coughs and colds. We wish them speedy recoveries. Thanks to Mr Berry and Mrs Forsyth who have stepped in to replace them.

Students in Ruma Toru and Wha are busy preparing their speeches for our school speech competition. We aim to run as many of our regular events as possible at Alert Level 2 including our school cross country. We will send home a timetable so that you can come along to watch your children present their speeches or compete in the cross country at specific times as we work to manage numbers attending. **Cross country is planned for Friday 24th September and speeches for Wednesday 29th September.**

Mr Stuckey's work with Ruma Toru finishes at the end of term 3. We are having a farewell get together for Mr Stuckey on **Thursday 30th September**, combined with a school open afternoon, finishing with a BBQ around 6pm. The open afternoon is for families to come along and see what is happening at school. Classrooms will be open from 4pm providing an opportunity for you to come and have a chat with teachers. Rather than having specific conference times this term, teachers will be available to talk with you, and your children can share their classroom learning. If however, you would like a dedicated conference time to meet with your child's teacher, you can contact them to make an

appointment. Teachers will also contact you if there is something specific they would like to discuss with you. We will run some structured literacy sessions at 5pm to share our new literacy programme and Ruma Toru will have their camp meeting at 5.30pm while the BBQ is cooking. Please indicate on the attached slip if you will be attending so we can organise children for the structured literacy demonstration and also to assist with catering for Mr Stuckey's farewell.

Pet Day is fast approaching. This is always a favourite event at school and is well supported by our local and wider community. This year, **Pet Day is on Wednesday 27th October** - week 2, term 4.
