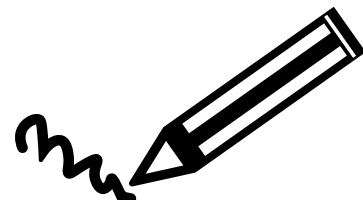

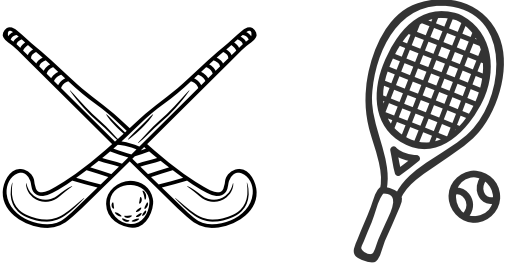

At Argyll East School farm. On Saturday and Sunday (11th to 12th, 18th to 19th, 23th to 27, 1st to 2nd).

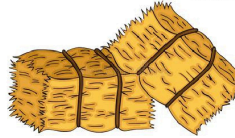
Anyone can help out.
